### **Dr Wyndham Wilson**

**M.D., Ph.D.**

Dr. Wilson obtained his MD and PhD and completed his medical residency at Stanford University. Following a fellowship in Medical Oncology at the National Cancer Institute, Dr. Wilson joined the faculty of the NCI as the Special Assistant to the Director, and later as a principal investigator. Dr. Wilson is currently the Chief, Hematological Malignancies Therapeutics Section, Metabolism Branch, Cancer Research Center, NCI. His interests are in the study of the biology and treatment of lymphoid malignancies and he directs phase I, II and III translational studies. His work has focused on targeted treatments and the development of new therapeutic strategies. He has a special interest in the treatment of diffuse large B-cell lymphoma and EBV-driven lymphoproliferative disorders. He has developed new curative treatments for subtypes of large cell lymphoma, Burkitt lymphoma and Lymphomatoid Granulomatosis. He has received numerous awards for his work. Currently he chairs multiple national committees including the Oncology Drug Advisory Committee (ODAC) for the FDA.

**Dr Miles Prince**

Miles Prince is a Haematologist and Professor/Director of Molecular Oncology and Cancer Immunology at Epworth Health Care and Director of the Centre for Blood Cell Therapy at Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre. His research focuses on clinical translational aspects of cancer immunology, genomics and epigenetics. He holds national and international grants and has led numerous clinical trials of new agents in myeloma, lymphoma and leukaemia. He is Director at the Snowdome Foundation, the International Society of Cutaneous Lymphoma and the Myeloma Foundation and the LymphomaHub. He has published over 390 journal articles and his work has been recognised with an Order of Australia.
